Event Information

Eligibility

This is an NSCA event. All NSCA members' targets must be registered. All participants competing for awards or cash must be current NSCA members.

To compete in your current class, you need a minimum of 500 registered targets in the current shooting year.

Rules

All NSCA and/or FITASC rules apply. All shoot jury and shoot management decisions are final. The jury will be posted on the scoreboard.

All protests must be in writing and addressed to the jury chairman, accompanied by a check for \$100 made payable to M & M Sporting Clays. If the jury rules in favor of the protest, the \$100 check will be returned to the protesting competitor. If the jury rules against the protest, the check will be retained by M & M Sporting Clays. The deadline for submitting a protest is 15 minutes after the last shot is fired on the day the incident took place. The jury's decision is final.

In accordance with NSCA rules, shoot management may refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot or, in management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike. There will be no refunds to any contestant expelled from the tournament.

Shooters Responsibility

It is the shooter's responsibility to see that he/she is placed in the correct class upon entering. Any shooter in the wrong class will be disqualified. Corrections to scores, event and concurrent entries must be reported to Registration as soon as they are noticed. Shooters are urged to check their scores each day, as corrections to awards will not be made unless registration is notified prior to the beginning of shoot-offs on the day of each event.

Safety Requirements

Mandatory eye and ear protection is required for all competitors, spectators, trappers, referees and workers on the shooting courses and practice areas. Those without adequate protection will be asked to leave the shooting areas.

Practice & Games

All games and Practice 5-Stand will accept cash or tickets. Tickets can be purchased at the ammo barn or main clubhouse. Cards for practice course can be purchased at the ammo barn.

Payouts

All payouts for options and cash prizes will be mailed. The shoot is required to report individual monetary winnings in excess of \$599 to the IRS for USA

residents. Failure to provide your Social Security Number will result in forfeiture of any and all prize monies. This information will be kept confidential and used only for the IRS reporting purposes.

Trophies

An award package will be mailed to winners that allows the winner to pick their award. Instructions will be included in the award package.

You will have until June 20, 2019 to send back your prize selection, failure to meet the date requirement will default to a M & M gift card.
