EVENT INFORMATION

Eligibility

This is an NSCA event. All NSCA members' targets must be registered. All participants competing for awards must be current NSCA members.

Rules

All NSCA and/or FITASC rules apply.

All protests must be in writing and addressed to the jury chairman. The jury will be posted on the scoreboard. The deadline for submitting a protest is 15 minutes after the last shot is fired on the day the incident took place.

In accordance with NSCA rules, shoot management may refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers, or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot, or, in management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike. There will be no refunds to any contestant expelled from the tournament

Jury and shoot management decisions are final.

Shooters Responsibility

Shooters are responsible to see that they are placed in the correct class upon entering. Any shooter in the wrong class will be disqualified. Corrections to scores, event, and concurrent entries must be reported to registration as soon as they are noticed. Shooters are urged to check their scores each day, as corrections to awards will not be made unless registration is notified before shoot-offs begin on the day of each event.

Safety Requirements

Eye and ear protection is required for all competitors, spectators, trappers, referees, and workers on the shooting courses and practice areas. Those without adequate protection will be asked to leave the shooting areas.

Practice & Games

All games and practice 5-Stand will accept cash or tickets. Tickets can be purchased at the ammo barn, main clubhouse, or apparel shop.

Gun Storage

Overnight gun storage is next to the ammo barn. We will provide you with a secure place to store your gun for \$10 a day or \$50 for the week. Gun storage will open daily at 7 am and close at 6:30 pm starting May $12^{\rm th}$ and ending Sunday, May $19^{\rm th}$. All guns must be in a hard case and locked. Soft cases will not be accepted.

Payouts

All payouts for options and cash prizes will be mailed. The shoot is required to report individual monetary winnings of more than \$599 by US residents to the IRS. Failure to provide your Social Security Number will result in the forfeiture of all prize monies. This information will be kept confidential and used only for tax reporting purposes.

Trophies

Award packages will be mailed to you so you can choose your prizes. Instructions will be included in the award package.

You will have until June 20, 2024 to return your prize selection. Failure to meet the date requirement will default to a M&M gift card.

Ammunition

Ammunition is available for sale. No reloads will be allowed in any event or game of this tournament. No loads larger than 7½ shot size. Bulk ammo sale/discounts for quantities of 10 cases or more will be available Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Competitor numbers will be issued at registration. Numbers must be worn for all events. Shooters not wearing numbers could be subject to disqualification per shoot management.

Golf Carts

Golf carts must be returned at the end of each day. If you do not return your golf cart, you will not be issued one the following day. Cart renters will be accountable for damage to their cart. Golf cart pick-up location will be designated on the event map. Golf carts and UTVs may not be used to reserve parking space for your car. Golf carts must be returned to trailer parking area or cart parking area. If you are camping on property you can keep your rented or personal golf cart at your campsite.

Marlins for Mason is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization started by Amanda Prather/Matarese (Mason's mother) and Anthony Matarese, Jr. (Mason's uncle) in 2023.

Mason, grandson of Anthony and Donna Matarese was diagnosed with Dravet Syndrome at 4 months old.

Dravet Syndrome is a rare, catastrophic, life-threatening and lifelong form of epilepsy that significantly affects all aspects of life. Mason suffers from frequent severe and prolonged seizures, developmental delays, feeding and mobility issues.

During his brief life, he has had hundreds of seizures, innumerable ER visits, and frequent hospitalizations. The treatments are both limited and ineffective, and nearly a quarter of children with Dravet Syndrome die before adulthood. Currently, there is no cure for this life-shattering condition.

Because Dravet Syndrome is rare, very little money is spent on research. Amanda and Anthony Matarese Jr launched Marlins for Mason to help raise awareness and fund research to search for better treatment options and hopefully some day a cure. All money raised by Marlins for Mason is donated directly to the Dravet Syndrome Foundation.

In 2023 Marlins for Mason donated \$312,457.94 to the Dravet Syndrome Foundation. This was the largest donation they had ever received. As a result of this donation, Marlins for Mason was able to independently fund a research project through the Dravet Syndrome Foundation.

In just one year Marlins for Mason is already making a big impact on the Dravet Syndrome world and with your help we will continue to work towards better treatments and hopefully someday a cure.






